GONSKI COLT A HIT ON THE GOLD COAST

Twenty five exciting racetrack prospects sold for \$100,000 or more during the Magic Millions National Horses in Training Sale at the Gold Coast on October 27 & 28.

Well bred and conformed two-year-olds who impressed at breeze up sessions around the country were the subject of good interest as over \$8.3 million of trade was completed.

Dulacca based Kenmore Lodge provided the top priced seller when their colt by Gonski sold for \$180,000 close to the end of the first session.

The colt, pin hooked from the Adelaide Yearling Sale in March for \$15,000, was snapped up by South African based bloodstock agent Andy Williams.

Bred by Dr Terry and John Hodgson of Riva Ridge Stud the colt is the sixth foal of the lightly raced Hurricane Sky mare Blazing Sky - a half sister to stakes winners Si Senior and Bello Signor.

SA STALLIONS & WINNERS October 9 – November 13

Kambula Stud's favourite son **Blevic** enjoys a position in the top forty sires in Australia with the winners of over three quarters of a million dollars in the first three and a half months of the season.

Promising stayer **Moudre** (pictured) has contributed a little under half of his earnings winning the Group Three VRC Queen Elizabeth Stakes on November 6. He was one of nine individual winners for the period including the Morphettville winners Beldara, Daydream Charlie and Marion Bay.

Lindsay Park resident **Good Journey** is on target for his best season with over \$400,000 earned in the first quarter of the season.

His number one performer is the handsome Sound Journey who captured the Group Two MVRC Crystal Mile on Cox Plate day.

Associate and second season sire **Barely A Moment** is making steady inroads with six winners thus far this season – five during the past month – including the Morphettville winners Fleet Riane and Little Fireball.

Well related filly **Sultah** recorded a valuable city win at the Moonee Valley night meeting on November 12. The daughter of Exceed and Excel is a half-sister to stakes winners Rebel Raider and Shamoline Warrior bred by Toorak Park Stud. Their dam Picholine produced a colt by Reset (a full-brother to Rebel Raider) on September 23.

Tiberius – a Shamardal half-brother to stakes winners I'm Discreet and Very Discreet – made a winning debut at Morphettville on November 4.

Trainer and breeder Paul Seater has found a likely replacement for his former smart 3YO Bundle O' Gold – sold to Hong Kong in 2008 after his MRC Zeditave Stakes win.

Half-brother **Gold Bundle**, by Keep the faith, bred in partnership with Gary Martin's Marant Group, was an impressive winner at Morphettville on November 13.

Bordertown trainer/breeder Sharon and husband Kym Hayes celebrated a Spring stakes win when **Status Symbol** won the Listed VRC Crown Promenade Stakes on Oaks Day. The Hayes' co-bred the daughter of Hemingway from their New Regent mare New Status.

Breeder-Administrator Bert Wickes dies aged 87. Veteran Tasmanian breeder, administrator, author, publisher & broadcaster Bert Wicks has died in Hobart aged 87. Wicks (who served in the RAAF during WW1) was on the board of the Thoroughbred Breeders Australia for many years. As a studmaster, he stood 1953 Melbourne Cup winner Wodalla and later Lanesborough who sired the 1970 Caulfield Cup winner & 1972 Melbourne Cup winner Piping Lane.

THE RUN DOWN ON REAAN

Reaan is a son of Chilean wonder sire Hussonet, most notable in these parts as the sire of Weekend Hussler.

He is the first Australian Group One winner to represent his sire at stud in Australia.

He is the second foal of the Danehill mare Ribe, winner of the Group Two MVRC Moonee Valley Oaks.

Reaan won the 2008 MRC Blue Diamond Preview enroute to a win in the \$1,015,000 Blue Diamond itself.

Reaan served 60 mares in his first book.

A son of Danehill, Churchill Downs won the MVRC Bill Stutt Stakes and Tatt's NSW Widden Stakes. Donatella, by Oakleigh Plate winner Mighty Avalanche, is a full sister to Sandown Guineas and Red Roses stakes winner Blixen.

2. Bay colt born October 22 by Al Samer from the Straussbrook mare Dance on Tables.

A son of Redoute's Choice, Al Samer won the Black Opal and Darby Munro Stakes. He has produced this spring's promising three year old Mr Chard winner of the Carbine Club and Gothic Stakes from his first crop. This colt is a half-brother to city winner Daydream Charlie.

3. Sandra and Malcolm Hale reveal the first photo of their eagerly awaited Street Sense colt.

Bay colt born October 2 by Street Sense (by Street Cry) from the Mountain Cat (by Storm Cat) mare Mountcat.

Mountcat is a half-sister to the dam of Zenyatta, the record breaking daughter of Street Cry who won 19 of her 20 starts and over US\$7 million.
