SA BRED STAKESWINNER HAIL CAPTAIN: SONADOR STARS IN EPSOM

Captain Sonador br h 2006

Captain Sonador joined the Group One club at Randwick when he scored a brilliant win in the \$500,000 Group One Epsom Handicap (1600m) on October 2.

Coming with a perfectly timed run under proven big race rider Glen Boss, Captain Sonador held out the more fancied runner Trusting to win in great style.

The win was the first at racing's elite level for renowned Queensland trainer Roger Milne.

"I'm a dreamer and my dream's came true today."

Captain Sonador, who is trained from the private property of owner Gregg Wagner outside Toowoomba, was given a strong each way chance following a third placing in the Group Three Bill Ritchie Handicap behind Drumbeats.

Wagner purchased his star galloper for just \$30,000 from the draft of Mill Park at the 2008 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale.

Captain Sonador, a son of leading Darley shuttler Shamardal, is one of two runners and two winners

produced by the multiple Adelaide winner Pushing Daisies.

By Kenny's Best Pal, who is the broodmare sire of another Epsom winner in Racing to Win, Pushing Daisies is a half sister to the former outstanding racemare Umaline.

Umaline is now making her name as a broodmare - being the dam of stakes winner Fasline and stakes placed Adelaide galloper Furline.

Celebrating the win from the Limestone Coast of South Australia was the Watson family of Mill Park.

They bred and sold Captain Sonador and importantly still own and breed with his dam Pushing Daisies.

The latest yearling from Pushing Daisies, a half sister to Captain Sonador by Not a Single Doubt, is being prepared by the Watson's for January's Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale.

"She is a quality filly," Magic Millions South Australian Manager Tim Brown reported. "She's always been a lovely individual and she's now a half sister to an Epsom winner!"

"I've seen a lot of Not a Single Doubt yearlings and she is right up there with the best of them," Brown added.

The S.A. Thoroughbred Breeders AGM was held on Tuesday, 28th September 2010 and was attended by 28 members. Treasurer Bob Dinham presented the financial report for 2009/2010 which showed that after putting a considerable amount back into the industry by way of sponsorship we are still in a good financial position. (If any members would like to have a copy of the financial statements posted to them, please contact the SATB office). With the retirement of Peter Smith from the committee, Chris Watson from Mill Park was elected to the vacant position and we thank Peter for his service on the committee. After the formalities of the meeting were over there were very good open discussions on varied interests of the industry including the AI case, the coming introduction of PIC numbers (Property Identification Code), and the EADRA agreement. We would like to thank the members who attended and provided interesting views and comments.

PRESIDENTS REPORT 2009/2010

THOROUGHBRED BREEDERS AUSTRALIA

- Free membership was offered as part of a national membership drive so that TBA can claim to represent a large numbers of individuals as well as the state bodies when talking on behalf of the breeders to governments. It is very important that TBA can argue this national approach.
- AI case is proceeding before the courts in Sydney. TBA has now joined the case as an interested party as we believe the consequences for the industry would be catastrophic particularly for the small breeders and studs. We expect this case to be heard in August of next year but may drag on into 2012.
- Animal Rights movement. Monitoring of extreme groups is taking place so that their impact on breeding and racing is managed.
- EADRA agreement. - The Australian Racing Board and Thoroughbred Breeders Australia have made submissions to the current senate enquiry, supporting a disease levy on registered horses but not on pony clubs and show events. Other associations are supporting a levy on manufactured feed and worming. TBA not supporting this action.

AUSHORSE

Ownership seminar held at Morphettville in February with speakers Sam Kavanagh, David Bridgland, Richard Jolly and Rob Slade and supported by Aushorse staff Rowena Smith and Jo McKinnon.

SABOIS

TRSA have provided the final figures for nominations of 2008 foals, which resulted in Breeder Paid 528 and Owner paid 380 - a total of 908 nominated foals, which is a slight overall increase on the previous year. Total amount of SABOIS bonuses paid for the 2009/10 season was \$1,776,775.

We have again been requesting that TRSA consider increasing the fund as well over 90% of all bonuses remain in the hands of South Australian owners.

SPONSORSHIP

- The S.A. Thoroughbred Breeders sponsored the Listed Laelia Stakes for \$10,000 and hosted a hospitality area for our members. A Draw was conducted during the day for \$2000 towards a stallion service fee and was won by member Sam Turner. A Bonus of \$5000 was offered if a SABOIS qualified horse won the race - one only qualifier in the race and it was the winner I'm Discreet. The owner/breeder was David Peacock.
- We sponsored a race and 2 committee members attended the Mt. Gambier Summer Cup meeting.
- We also sponsored a race during the Pt. Lincoln Carnival and committeemembers attended and hosted a hospitality area and made the presentation of our annual award to the Leading West Coast Breeder which was won by Ross Lyons.
- Award given at apprentice awards night to the Apprentice with the most winners for the season, won by Libby Hopwood.

SALES

- A Mail out to over 2500 trainers throughout Australia promoting sales was carried out.
- We again ran a Hospitality Marquee during sales for members and guests
- The Courtesy Bus was very well supported.
- Overall the sales were better than expected.

AWARDS DINNER

Held at the Panasonic Pavilion at Morphettville with 230 in attendance. Matrice Award was presented to Ken and Helen Smith for their service to the industry.

The Horse of the Year was Nicconi in a close finish with his half brother Niconero.

Dr. Cam Baker was awarded life membership of the Association for 21 years service on the committee.

SEMINAR

Seminar held with Paul Carrazzo Tax Consultant, Dr. Rob Rahaley from PIRSA and Professor Chris Riley from Roseworthy Campus.

BLUEBLOODS SUPPLEMENT

Third edition of our "Spotlight on South Australia" was produced and sent out with the Bluebloods August issue.

TOUR

In September 2009 conducted a tour to the studs in the Hunter Valley with 20 of our members.
