Mill Park Stud lead the South Australian Vendors on the opening day of the Magic Millions Adelaide Yearling Sale.

There was a real South Australian flavour when the gavel dropped for \$110,000 on Lot 105 offered by leading South Australian Stud farm, Mill Park.

The Farnan colt bred by Brenton & Elizabeth Parker was purchased by Naracoorte based trainer Sue Murphy. The South Australian connection doesn't stop there. The dam of the colt is a half relation to three time Group One winner and 2014 South Australian Thoroughbred Breeders' Horse of the Year 'Happy Trails'.

The second and final day of the Magic Millions Adelaide sale, Mill Park Stud continues to shine as the most successful vendor overall. Notably, Lot 236, a Dalasan Filly bred by Harry Perks, Toorak Thoroughbred Breeding Trust, was sold to Macdonald Gluyas Racing for \$110,000 also remaining in South Australia.

The Magic Millions Yearling Sale sadly felt the brunt of a declining demand for yearlings as outside economic factors and a condensed sales schedule all combined to see trade drop below \$10 million.

The harsh realities of the Australian bloodstock market, and the widening gap between the haves and have-nots, were clearly felt.

The two-day event wrapped up on Friday, with overall 19 yearlings being sold for \$100,000 plus, of which two were bred in South Australia.



AROUND THE TRACKS FOR SA BRED



Bootlegger is a three-year-old gelding, bred from the pairing of Too Darn Hot and Princess Youmzain, trained by Dan Clarcken and Oopy MacGillivray. Bootlegger recorded his third race win, and first at black type level when successful in Monday Adelaide Cup Day Listed SAJC Morphettville Guineas (1600m).

A homebred for Robert Hill-Smith, who passed the horse in at the Inglis Premier yearling sale 2024 as a yearling after he failed to reach his \$125,000 reserve. Congratulations to all connections on this journey.
