### THE SA BRED MILL PARK GRADUATE TRIFECTA



Bassett Babe - Bred by Thoroughbred Breeding

A wonderful weekend on the track for Mill Park raised graduates. **Bassett Babe**, a 3-year-old filly (Wootton Bassett x Liberty Lover), bred by Harry Perks, Toorak Thoroughbred Breeding Trust. She remains unbeaten, achieving an impressive victory by two and three-quarter lengths at Morphettville Racecourse for Macdonald Gluyas Racing. A graduate of the Magic Millions yearling sale 2024.



Tough Talk - Bred by Thoroughbred Breeding

**Tough Talk**, a 4yo gelding (Saxon Warrior x Grabbing Glory) recording three straight this time in, winning at Morphettville Racecourse for Macdonald Gluyas Racing. Tough talk is a Magic Millions Adelaide yearling sale graduate also bred by Toorak Thoroughbred Breeding Trust.



Berkeley Square - Bred by David Peacock

**Berkeley Square**, 6 year old gelding (Territories x Bahamas) bred by SA Breeder David Peacock, Trained by Dan O'Sullivan Racing, it was the tenth win for the Berkeley Square taking his earnings past \$2.1m with a 2500m win at Flemington. A stellar effort with more to come. Congratulations to all connections.



Kirkliston Blu - Bred by Kirkliston Stud



### KIRKLISTON BLU STRATHALBYN CUP

**Kirkliston Blu**, son of stallion America, takes out the 2026 Strathalbyn Racing Club Cup over 2050 metres. Bred by Kirkliston Stud, SA, stepping up in distance, headed to Morphettville with the next best result being fourth in the Group 3 Lord Reims. A 6th win at Strath takes earnings to \$270,000.

Very worthy of mention is **Galaxy Patch**, an overall stellar performer. Galaxy Patch, a 6YO gelding sired by Wandjina, out of the More Than Ready mare, Voltara. He was bred by SA Breeders Rob and Maureen McBryde at Summerset Park. Racing in Hong Kong, his most recent race was on February 22, where he finished fourth in The Queen's Silver Jubilee Cup (Gr.1) over 1400 metres at Sha Tin. Having 26 starts, his record is 10 wins, 5 seconds and one 1 third.

# Vale Quemán

Earlier this month, Quemán, a Group 1 champion and one of South Australia's top sprinters in recent years, has sadly passed away due to complications from colic.

This seven-year-old, trained by Shane and Cassie Oxlade, will be fondly remembered for his victory in the 2024 Oakleigh Plate at Caulfield.

Bred and owned by Francis (Boof) Smith and his family, Quemán amassed over \$1 million in prize money, achieving 10 wins, including three at the stakes level, throughout his 26-start career.

His Oakleigh Plate win, where he triumphed over Hypothetical and Mornington Glory with Harry Coffey riding, also marked the Oxlades' first Group 1 success.

As a son of Mint Lane, Quemán made a comeback after an extended break at the start of the 2025/2026 racing season, claiming victory in the Behemoth Stakes at Morphettville.



Be assured that there's plenty of parking!


Due to the neighbouring development, some land is unavailable that had been utilised in previous years.

There is around 180 vehicle capacity on site with a 400 plus vehicle capacity at the adjacent oval (Plympton Bulldogs), float parking for vendors at the Show jumping grounds near the airport.

ENTRY Multiple gates on Park Terrace will be used for controlled access with 24/7 security. Vendors and VIP buyers will receive permits for reserved onsite parking.

Additionally, the trams are back up and running with Plympton stop two minutes away – a 12 minute tram ride to Glenelg or 23 minutes to the city centre. Both quicker than going by car! Looking forward to a great sale.

## Racing SA Announces Free Racing Rewards Nominations for South Australian Breeders

**Racing SA** is pleased to announce an enhancement to the Racing Rewards Bonus scheme to support the breeding community in South Australia.

Effective immediately, all Category 2 & 3 Nominations for the Racing Rewards Bonus Scheme will join Category 1 nominations being free, providing breeders/nominators with financial relief of \$550 (Cat. 2) and \$825 (Cat. 3) (inc. GST) per Yearling.

All SA-bred yearlings will be included in Racing SA's lucrative Racing Rewards Bonus Scheme, which provides approximately \$3m annually in bonuses to breeders, nominators, owners, trainers and jockeys.

Further benefits of this initiative are that Racing SA will automatically register SA-bred horses into the scheme via the Stud Book, and for those that had already paid nomination fees for 2024 foals (Category 2 & 3), fees will be refunded.

Nick Bawden, CEO of Racing SA, reaffirmed the commitment to supporting the state's breeding industry. "We want to ensure that our local breeders and owners have every opportunity to thrive. These incentive changes reflect our partnership with the breeders' association and our dedication to nurturing the future of South Australian racing."

South Australian Thoroughbred Breeders President and Willow Grove Stud Owner/Operator Ralph Satchell said, "I want to express our sincere appreciation to the Board and Staff at Racing SA for their collaborative efforts leading to this positive development, which aims to assist breeders in South Australia and promote the growth and viability of South Australian racing."

Satchell continued, "As the thoroughbred industry and breeding in South Australia continue to evolve towards quality broodmare stock, initiatives like this play a critical role in sustaining and growing the local breeding community, ensuring that South Australia remains a vibrant contributor to the racing landscape."

**AgriFutures Australia** has launched the **People and Capability Program**, offering up to \$200,000 to combat workforce shortages and enhance skills in Levied and Emerging Industries.

### ***Importance of the Program***

Workforce shortages hinder growth and competitiveness in rural industries. The program targets practical, industry-led initiatives to attract and retain talent across sectors.

### ***Available Funding***

Two grant streams:

**Industry Workforce Program Grants:** Up to \$25,000 for workforce initiatives.

**Capacity Building Grants:** Up to \$10,000 for leadership and skill development.

Invest in people and create pathways into agriculture while measuring outcomes for immediate and future workforce needs.


### ***Who Can Apply***

**Thoroughbred Breeders Australia (TBA)** is guiding members on Foal Ownership Declaration (FOD) obligations to ensure compliance and reduce non-lodgement risks. Key points include:

- Lodgement Requirements: Mare Returns and FODs must be submitted within 30 days of a foal's birth via the Stud Book website. Late submissions incur fees and may lead to embargoes, making foals ineligible to race.
- Embargoes and Appeals: FODs submitted after 60 days result in automatic embargoes. Appeals must show "special or exceptional circumstances" and lack of awareness is insufficient for success.
- Common Issues: Many embargoes stem from administrative errors, such as miscommunication about lodging responsibilities or incorrect contact details.
- Action Steps: Members should review mare and foal records, confirm lodgements, and not assume others have completed the process.
- Support: Members needing assistance with appeals or impacted by embargoes should contact Meagan McGrath at TBA for help. [meagan@tbaus.com](mailto:meagan@tbaus.com)

TBA is actively engaging with Racing Australia to address these challenges and improve the process for members.
