ON TRACK HIGHLIGHTS FOR SA BRED

Queman made a remarkable return at Morphettville, clinching victory in the Group 3 SAJC Behemoth Stakes on August 9th after a 69-week hiatus. Prior to this, he triumphed in the Listed WJ Adam Stakes and the Group 1 Oakleigh Plate, marking the first elite victory for his trainers, Shane and Cassie Oxlade of Woodchester.

After recovering from a sesamoid injury ahead of the 2024 Spring Carnival, Queman showcased his readiness with two jump outs leading up to the race.

Bred and raced by Boof Smith and his family, Queman is the first foal and winner out of the Clangalang mare, Langreen, and is sired by Mint Lane. His win in the Behemoth Stakes pushed his total earnings past the \$1 million mark.

Recording her third black type victory, the talented Too Darn Hot mare, Too Darn Discreet, seems poised for more spring success after clinching the Listed Heatherlie Stakes (1700m) at Caulfield under the guidance of trainer Dan O'Sullivan.

She had previously won two starts ago before narrowly missing out on August 16^{th,} being defeated by El Rocko. Bred and partly owned by David Peacock, Too Darn Discreet is a half-sister to the stakes-placed, five-time winner Really Discreet and is the fourth winner from four foals sired by Shamardal's Group 1 SAJC Schweppes Oaks champion, Maybe Discreet.

Too Darn Discreet has had 12 starts and so far amassed over \$625,000 and is a finalist for the SA Thoroughbred Breeder's Horse of the Year for 24/25.

INDUSTRY NEWS



Thoroughbred Breeders Australia (TBA) wishes to remind breeders that strict penalties are being enforced for late Foal Ownership Declarations from 1 August 2025.


Under the updated Racing Australia penalties, all foals must have their details confirmed within 30 days of birth to avoid an increased fee. Any foal not registered within 60 days of birth will be subject to a racing embargo, unless the owners successfully appeal. (Click here for further information from Racing Australia).

While TBA continues to work with Racing Australia to minimise the impact of these changes, it is vital that breeders act promptly to avoid penalties by lodging all mare returns/Foal Ownership Declarations (FODs) within 30 days of a foal's birth. Support for you during this process:

- Streamlined process: The mare return and FOD are now a single process. For best results, complete it on a PC rather than a smartphone or tablet.
- Step-by-step guide: View the Stud Book's 'How To' user guide here.
- State Breeding Organisation support: Your State Breeding Organisation Executive Officer can assist if you need help.
- Stud Book assistance: The Stud Book team is also available to provide support.
 Contact them on 02 8072 1900 or email studbook@racingaustralia.horse; they have also prepared this useful FAQ document
- Stud farm assistance: Stud farms can complete the process on behalf of owners.
 Ensure you confirm who will be lodging the combined mare return/FOD for each mare and foal well ahead of the 30-day deadline.

For new breeders: Make sure you have a Contact Breeder Number and that your mare is registered for breeding. There is no cost for either process.

We strongly encourage all breeders to put systems in place now to ensure timely lodgement and avoid unnecessary costs or restrictions.
