

News from around the Sales SA Breeders positive results at the Adelaide Magic Millions Sale



Lot 34 - Too Darn Hot x Just Discreet (Exceed and Excel) - \$180,000 from Mill Park Stud on behalf of renowned Adelaide breeder David Peacock. The scopey athletic Too Darn Hot Colt is from Group 3 winner Just Discreet, he was snapped up by leading South Australian Trainer Michael Hickmott for John O'Neil and the Punt Road Racing Syndicate.

Lot 35 - Tornado x Kabini (Written Tycoon) - \$225,000 from historic Balcrest Stud celebrating their 90th year of operation, the athletic Tornado colt with a great temperament, was knocked down to Shane McGrath and will head to Clinton McDonalds stable in Victoria. The Colt is the first foal of a dual Group 3 placed Written Tycoon mare Kabini.

Lot 61 - The Autumn Sun x Le Societe (Anabaa) - \$200,000 bred by Cornerstone Stud the highly popular and smooth walking Autumn Sun Colt was purchased by Paul Moroney & Catherine Bruggeman on behalf of Ballymore Stables. The colt is a 1/2 brother to Geelong Classic winner Grand Pierro and speedy stakes placed 2yo Sebring filly Indiscretion.

Day 2 of the sale remained consistent for most and challenging for others with some good results from local vendors including Mill Park, Rathmore, Little Hills Pastoral, Angas Bank, Cornerstone, Willow Grove and Kambula.

Retired anaesthetist, Terry Hodgson, a local breeder sold his only entry under Glenn Lee Thoroughbreds (VIC) draft selling his Filly, a Hellbent out his mare Snowflight to local trainer Michael Hickmott for \$100,000.

Overall, across the two days of the Adelaide Yearling Sale, over 15.37 million was grossed on 306 lots sold at an average price of \$50,259 and a clearance rate of 79 percent. A large amount of withdrawals impacted on the gross.

SA Breeders results from the March Inglis Premier Sale

Lindsay Park Racing went hard to secure the Mill Park produced So You Think X Miss Otto, he's a brother to Group 2 winner and million-dollar earner on the track and now stallion standing at stud, Peltzer. Mill Park sold 9 yearlings across the sale, averaging \$138,000.

Willow Grove Stud knocked it out of the park with their outstanding Ole Kirk x Kibibi Colt, after a spirited bidding duel the colt eventually sold to B&J Racing NSW for \$400,000 making him the second most expensive Ole Kirk colt sold this year for first season stallion. Willow Grove sold 3 yearlings and finished in the top 10 leading vendors achieving an average of \$175,000.
